

## Clayton Decoy Auction – July 17, 2026 (88 lots, 106 items, 275 photos)

- Lot #1: Drake wood duck by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative preening decoy with detailed paint, raised wing tips, relief carved wings and tail feathers. Head turned back to the right with texturing on the back of the crest. Original paint in very good condition with a few speckles of paint. Overall length of approx. 12&1/4 inches. Harris brand on the bottom and dated 1975. Estimated \$400-500.
- Lot #2: Redhead drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting style decoy but does not appear to have been rigged for use, head turned slightly to the right. Original paint in excellent condition. Overall length of approx. 13 inches. Harris stamp, and 1967 scratched into the bottom. Estimated \$150-200.
- Lot #3: Drake canvasback by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint, raised wing tips, relief carved wings and tail feathers. Head turned slightly to the left. Original paint in very good condition with a few spots of dirt. Overall length of approx. 14 inches. Harris brand on the bottom. Estimated \$300-350.
- Lot #4: Drake long-tailed duck (old squaw) with “Ken Harris Decoys, Woodville, NY” and “By Tom Ferguson” burned into the bottom. Decorative model with detailed paint and long tail. Raised wing tips and primaries with fine texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Approx. 16&1/2 inches long overall, dated 1980, and with the head turned slightly to the left. In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #5: Decoy lamp by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative drake blue-winged teal with relief carved wing and tail feathers in excellent condition and original paint. Decoy mounted on an oval base that is approx. 10 inches long with Harris brand on the bottom of the base. Lamp in working order. Estimated \$150-200.
- Lot #6: Miniature drake wood duck by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in very good condition except for some tiny speckles of paint and dirt. Overall length of approx. 6&1/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.
- Lot #7: Black duck by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Early sock-eye hunting style decoy. Note on the bottom indicates this decoy was made in 1940 and repainted by Leo McIntosh in 1985. Paint in excellent condition. Overall length of approx. 15&1/2 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$150-225.
- Lot #8: Mallard pair with “Ken Harris Decoys, Woodville, NY” and “By Tom Ferguson” burned into their bottoms. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with fine texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. The drake is approx. 15&1/4 inches long with the head turned to the right. The hen is approx. 14&1/2 inches long, dated 1981 on the bottom, with the head turned to the left. The hen is in excellent condition and original paint. The drake is in very nice original paint with minor damage to both wing tips, several tiny chips, and some spotting and bleeding of sap through the paint. Estimated \$200-300.
- Lot #9: Drake wood duck half-flyer with Ken Harris stamp on the back side. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the right side with the wing angled down. Approx. 14&1/2 inches long. In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$250-300.
- Lot #10: Mallard hen by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with relief-carved wings and tail feathers. Head turned slightly to the right. Original paint in very good condition. Overall length of approx. 15&3/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$175-250.

- Lot #11: Green-winged teal pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 10&1/2 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1994. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #12: Drake redhead by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint, and head turned to the left. Original paint in excellent condition. Overall length of approx. 13 inches. Harris brand on the bottom. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #13: Hooded merganser pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 12&1/4 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms. Drake dated 1995, hen dated 1997. The hen is in excellent condition and original paint. The drake is also in original paint and in excellent condition except for some damage to the wing tips. Estimated \$250-350.
- Lot #14: Wood duck drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with a high head turned to the left. Low relief-carved wings. Original paint in very good condition. Overall length of approx. 12&3/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$225-300.
- Lot #15: Miniature drake blue-winged teal by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in very good condition except for a few tiny speckles of paint and dirt. Head turned slightly to the right. Overall length of approx. 6&1/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.
- Lot #16: Miniature drake mallard by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in very good condition. Overall length of approx. 7&1/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.
- Lot #17: Drake blue-winged teal by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint and head turned slightly to the left. Original paint in excellent condition. Overall length of approx. 11 inches. Harris brand on the bottom. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #18: Hen green-winged teal by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Head turned to the left, approx. 10 inches long, branded and signed on the bottom, and dated 1992. In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$250-350.
- Lot #19: Mallard drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with relief-carved wings and head turned nearly 90° to the right. Original paint in very good condition with one small spot of touchup on top of the head. Overall length of approx. 13&1/2 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$225-300.
- Lot #20: Blue-winged teal pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 10&1/2 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1996. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #21: Drake pintail half-flyer with Ken Harris stamp on the back side. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the right side with the wing extending straight above the body. Approx. 18&1/4 inches long. In very good condition and original paint except for some small speckles of dirt and paint. Estimated \$250-300.

- Lot #22: Ruddy duck pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. The drake is approx.. 12 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches long with an upswept tail, and the head turned to the right. The hen is approx.. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, with the head turned to the left. Both branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1997. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #23: Decoy lamp by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting style drake wood duck with the lamp and several simulated cattail leaves mounted through the back-left side of the decoy. The decoy is approx. 13 inches long with Harris stamp on the bottom. Lamp in working order. Estimated \$100-150.
- Lot #24: Mallard pair by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting style decoys which do not appear to have been rigged for use. The drake's head turned to the left. Both in original paint in very good condition with beautiful feathering and combing. A knot has bled through the paint on the right side of the hen. Overall length of the drake approx. 14 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches, approx. 15 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches for the hen. Harris stamps on their bottoms. Estimated \$350-450.
- Lot #25: Goldeneye pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1996. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #26: Miniature drake wood duck by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in very good condition except for a few speckles of paint and dirt. Overall length of approx. 5 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.
- Lot #27: Canvasback pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake approx.. 14 inches long, head turned to the right. Hen approx.. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, head turned to the left. Both branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1995. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #28: Drake blue-winged teal half-flyer with Ken Harris stamp on the back side. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the left side with the wing angled down slightly. Approx. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long. In very good condition and original paint except for a slight separation at the neck-body joint. Estimated \$250-300.
- Lot #29: Preening black duck by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Head turned back to the right, approx. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, branded and signed on the bottom, and dated 1995. In very good condition and original paint. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #30: Wood duck drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Head turned slightly to the right. Original paint in very good condition. Overall length of approx. 13 inches. Harris brand on the bottom. Estimated \$225-300.
- Lot #31: Pair of gadwall by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1995. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #32: Miniature drake blue-winged teal by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in very good condition. Slight separation at the neck base. Overall length of approx. 5 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.

- Lot #33: Drake blue-winged teal by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint, relief carved tail feathers, and head turned slightly to the right. Original paint in excellent condition. Overall length of approx. 10&1/4 inches. Harris brand on the bottom and dated 1973. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #34: Model of a three masted square rigged war ship with 18 guns below deck, nine on each side. Mounted on a rectangular base. In very good condition. Estimated \$150-300.
- Lot #35: Pair of long-tailed ducks (old squaw) by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. The drake with a long tail, head turned to the right, and measuring approx.. 16&1/4 inches long. The hen measures approx.. 12 inches long with the head turned to the left. Both are dated 1997. The drake is in excellent condition and original paint. The hen is also in original paint and in excellent condition except for some damage to the wing tips. Estimated \$300-350.
- Lot #36: Pintail drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with long tail and relief-carved tail feathers. Head turned to the right. Tight crack in the bottom and right side of the neck. Detailed original paint in excellent condition. Overall length of approx. 17&1/4 inches, with the elongated tail feather contributing about 4 inches. Harris brand on the bottom. Estimated \$250-350.
- Lot #37: Drake mallard half-flyer by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the left side with the wing angled down. Approx. 15&1/4 inches long; branded, and with a statement burned into the wood "Last plaque carved by Ferguson Decoys 4/8/95". In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #38: Drake canvasback by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint, and head turned to the right. Original paint in excellent condition. Very thin separation of the head and body evident at the front. Overall length of approx. 14 inches. Harris brand on the bottom. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #39: Shoveler pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 13&1/2 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms. Drake dated 1996, hen dated 1997. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #40: Decoy lamp by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative drake green-winged teal with raised wing tips and texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail; in excellent condition and original paint except for a tiny chip on the end of the tail. Decoy mounted on an oval base that is approx. 9&3/4 inches long with Harris brand on the bottom of the base. Lamp in working order. Estimated \$150-200.
- Lot #41: Drake blue-winged teal half-flyer with Ken Harris brand on the back side. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the left side with the wing angled down. Approx. 14&1/2 inches long. In good condition and original paint except the head appears to have been broken off at the base of the neck with repair and touchup in that area. Estimated \$100-150.
- Lot #42: Black duck by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting decoy in original paint with light overall wear. Approx. 14&3/4 inches long, tiny tail chip, and with an age check extending across the bottom and part way up the breast and under the tail. Faded Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$100-125.
- Lot #43: Mallard drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with relief-carved wings. Original paint in very good condition but with tiny speckles of paint and dirt, and some yellowing. End of

tail slightly blunted with tiny chips in the paint. Overall length of approx. 14 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$150-200.

- Lot #44: Miniature drake bluebill by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in generally good condition. Chip missing from the bottom-left edge of the tail. Head turned slightly to the left. Overall length of approx. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.
- Lot #45: Red breasted merganser pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned slightly to the left. Both approx. 13 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms. Drake dated 1994, hen dated 1997. The drake is in excellent condition and original paint. The hen is also in original paint and in excellent condition except for some damage to the bill tip. Estimated \$250-350.
- Lot #46: Book end attributed to Ken Harris with the front one-third of a drake mallard. Book end approx. 5 $\frac{1}{4}$  inches long with the remains of a Harris stamp on the bottom. In very good condition with a little dirt and a few tiny speckles of paint. Estimated \$50-75.
- Lot #47: Very rare brant by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Head turned slightly to the right, a little over 18 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, branded and signed on the bottom, and dated 1999. In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$250-350.
- Lot #48: Drake wood duck by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting style decoy but does not appear to have been rigged for use, head turned slightly to the right. Very nice original paint in excellent condition except that it appears to be somewhat faded. Overall length of approx. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$150-200.
- Lot #49: Bufflehead pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 11 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1992. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #50: Decoy lamp by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Drake mallard with relief carved wings and tail feathers in excellent condition and original paint. Decoy approx. 14 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches long with Harris stamp on the bottom. Lamp in working order and notched into the right bottom edge of the decoy. Estimated \$100-150.
- Lot #51: Bluebill pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1996. Both in generally excellent condition and original paint. The drake with minor damage to the wing tips. The hen with minor damage to the wing tips and the top and bottom left corners of the tail, and a small missing flake of paint on the bill tip. Estimated \$250-350.
- Lot #52: Hen gadwall half-flyer with "Ken Harris Decoys, Woodville, NY" and "By Tom Ferguson, 1981" burned into the back side. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the right side with wing angled down. Approx. 17 $\frac{1}{4}$  inches long. In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #53: Miniature drake mallard by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in generally good condition except for a neck break and some paint rubs on the head and neck. Overall length of approx. 7 $\frac{1}{4}$  inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.

- Lot #54: Miniature drake mallard by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Original paint in generally good condition but with spots of discoloration. Overall length of approx. 7&1/2 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$75-100.
- Lot #55: Redhead pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 12&1/4 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms. Drake dated 1996, hen dated 1997. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #56: Rare loon by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Head turned slightly to the right, bill open and holding a carved yellow perch approx. 4&3/4 inches long. The loon is approx. 20&3/4 inches long, branded and signed on the bottom, and dated 2000. In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$350-450.
- Lot #57: Mallard hen by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting style decoy but does not appear to have been rigged for use, head turned to the right. Original paint with nice feathering and scratch paint; but with scattered small chips. Neck crack, tight check in the back, and with damage to the tip of the bill. Overall length of approx. 15&3/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$100-150.
- Lot #58: Black duck pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head (yellow bill) turned to the right, hen's head (greenish bill) turned to the left. Both approx. 14&3/4 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1999. Both in very good condition with nice original paint. Hen has some tiny speckles of paint, mostly near the neck base; the drake also has some tiny speckles of paint, and two small chips at the front bottom edge of the breast. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #59: Decoy lamp by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting style drake canvasback with the lamp mounted through the back-left side of the decoy. The decoy is approx. 15 inches long with Harris stamp on the bottom. Lamp in working order with some wear to the burlap covering on the lamp shade. Estimated \$100-150.
- Lot #60: Black duck by Pat Snyder, Alexandria Bay, NY. Oversize hunting decoy in good physical condition. Plain original paint on the body, more detailed paint on the head but with some chipping and wear to the bare wood. Approx. 18&1/4 inches long with Pat's "Swan Hollow Decoy" brand on the bottom. Estimated \$50-75.
- Lot #61: Drake pintail drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Life-size hunting style decoy but never rigged for use. Original paint in excellent condition but with a knot bleeding through the paint on the right side. Overall length of approx. 14&1/4 inches. Smearred Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$150-200.
- Lot #62: Cinnamon teal pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 10&3/4 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms. Drake dated 1994, hen dated 1995. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #63: Model of the Cutty Sark, a three masted square rigged sailing ship, mounted on a rectangular base. In very good condition. Estimated \$150-300.
- Lot #64: Hen blue-winged teal half-flyer with remains of a Ken Harris stamp on the back side. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the left side with the wing extending straight

outward. Two-piece body, approx. 16&1/4 inches long. In good condition and original paint except for numerous tiny speckles of paint and a small chip at the end of the tail. Estimated \$200-250.

- Lot #65: Preening drake mallard by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Head turned back to the right, approx. 13&1/2 inches long, branded and signed on the bottom, and dated 1994. In very good condition and original paint. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #66: Drake green-winged teal by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Tucked head decorative model with detailed paint, raised wing tips, relief carved wings and tail feathers. Head turned to the left. Original paint in generally excellent condition with some small paint chips on the right side of the head and two small dots of white paint on the left wing tip. Overall length of approx. 9&3/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$225-275.
- Lot #67: Hen green-winged teal by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint, raised wing tips, relief carved wings and tail feathers. Head turned slightly to the right. Original paint in excellent condition. Overall length of approx. 10&1/2 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$250-300.
- Lot #68: Hen mallard by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative model with detailed paint. Without raised wing tips but with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Head turned to the right, approx. 14&1/2 inches long, branded and signed on the bottom, and dated 2007. In very good condition and original paint, but with bubbles of pitch sprinkled across the body. Estimated \$150-200.
- Lot #69: Drake common (American) eider by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Two-thirds size decorative model with detailed paint and relief carved wings and tail feathers. Head turned to the right, approx. 12&1/2 inches long, branded and signed on the bottom, and dated 1996. In very good condition and original paint with a little dirt on the back. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #70: Hen gadwall half-flyer with "Ken Harris Decoys, Woodville, NY" and "By Tom Ferguson, 1981" burned into the back side. Designed to be mounted against a wall or background, showing the left side with wing angled down. Approx. 17&1/4 inches long. In excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$200-250.
- Lot #71: Mallard drake by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Hunting style decoy but does not appear to have been rigged for use, head turned to the left. Original paint with nice stippling and combing; some yellowing of the paint especially on the right side. Neck crack with some paint chips in the throat area. Overall length of approx. 15&1/4 inches. Harris stamp on the bottom. Estimated \$125-175.
- Lot #72: Harlequin duck pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail. Drake's head turned to the right, hen's head turned to the left. Both approx. 11 inches long, branded and signed on their bottoms, and dated 1998. Both in excellent condition and original paint. Estimated \$300-400.
- Lot #73: Decoy lamp by Ken Harris, Woodville, NY. Drake mallard with relief carved wings and tail feathers in excellent condition and original paint. Decoy approx. 14&1/2 inches long with faded Harris stamp on the bottom. Lamp in working order and notched into the right bottom edge of the decoy. Estimated \$100-150.

- Lot #74: Wigeon pair by Ferguson Decoys, Woodville, NY. Decorative models with detailed paint. Raised wing tips with texturing on the wing tips, primaries, and tail.
